



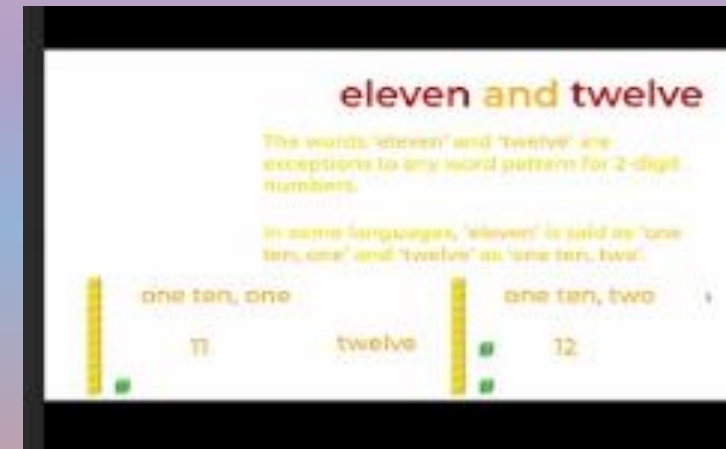
TEACHERS' WEBINARS AND WORKSHOPS FOR THE MONTH OF JULY SESSION 2023- 24

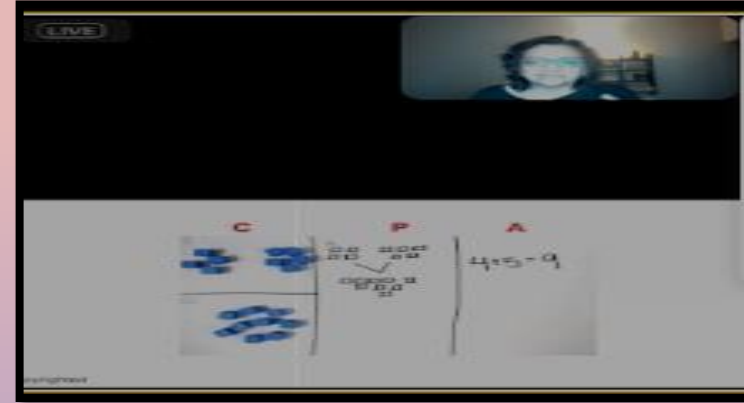
