## 'Rashtriya Ekta Diwas' - 31st October 2020






The assembly ended with a patriotic song, sung by classes-I & II, titled '*Ek tu hi bharosa ek tu hi* Sahara'.

The students of class 4 and 5 showed their participation in making of creative Posters on National Unity in Diversity.


