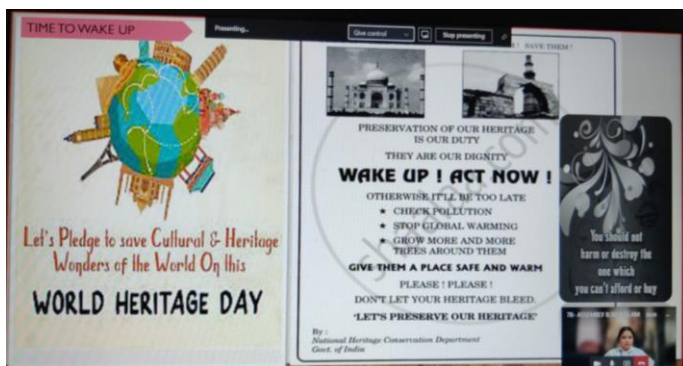
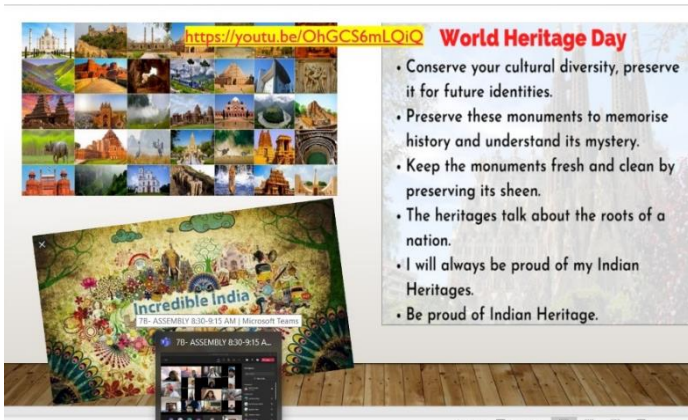


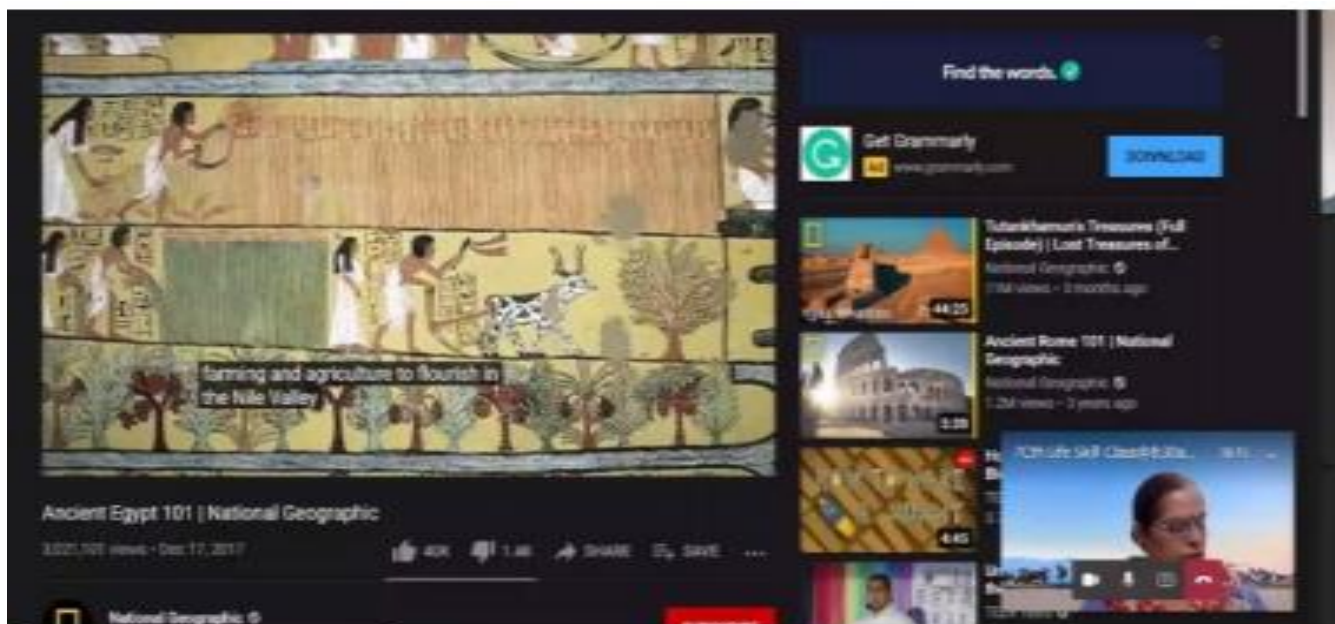
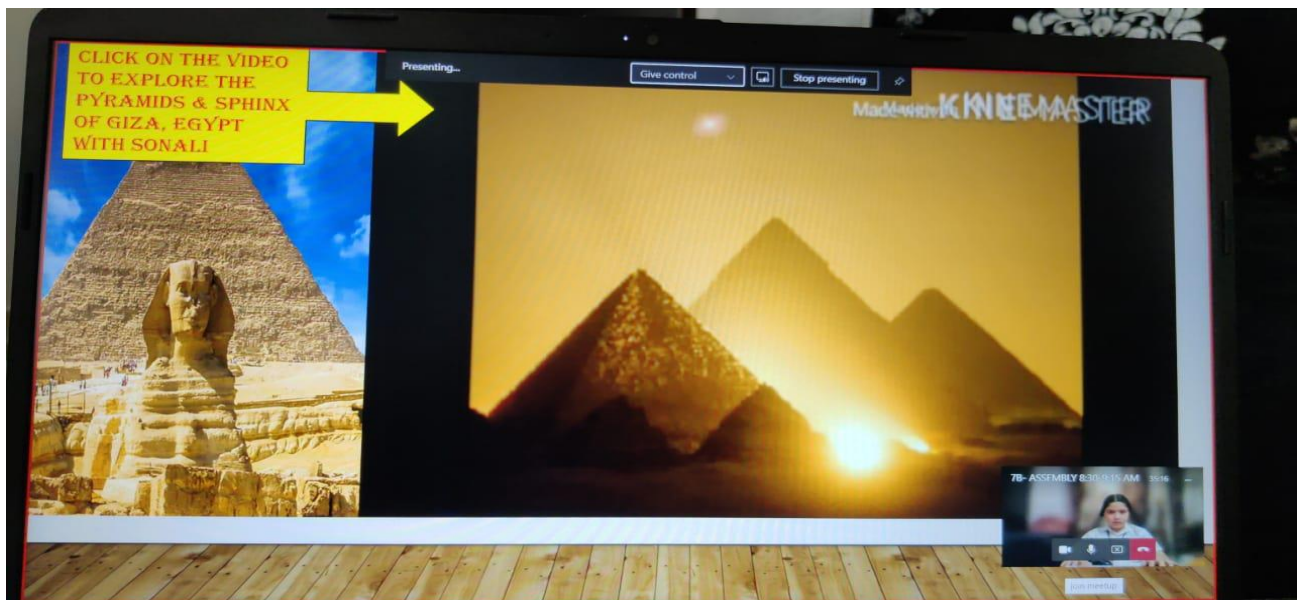
World Heritage Day-International Day for Monuments and Sites
