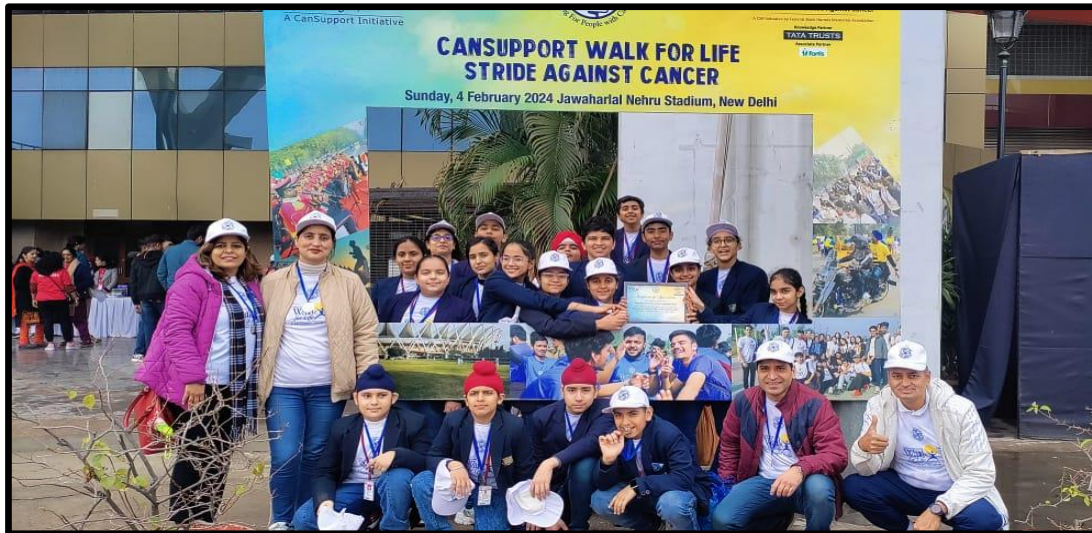


*A ribbon pink, like petals rare,
