Guidance for Parents- Project Showcase Session for Class II

On 23 December 2023, a parenting session was conducted by the school counselor specifically designed for the parents of Class II students. The objective of this session was to equip parents with the necessary guidance and strategies to support their children through their growing years.

The school counselor, served as the facilitator for the session and provided valuable insights into the preparation, expectations, and role of parents. She stressed upon the significance of connection, communication, and building trust in children.

Parents were encouraged to support and actively engage in the growing up years, providing a conducive environment at home for the child - Collaborating with the child's teacher and counselor to understand the child's progress- Offering moral support, guidance, and constructive feedback to help refine their child's journey of learning.
