In addition to academic learning, we also provide vocational skills and training to help children become independent and capable of earning a living in the future. The educational experience includes various creative teaching methods, educational games, and co-curricular activities. These activities not only make learning enjoyable but also create memorable experiences for the children.



A vibrant session was conducted, focusing on the topic 'India: Size and Location.' The session aimed to help students learn more about geography while also creating pride and curiosity about their country. Students took part by using maps of India to find and label different places. This hands-on activity helped them understand India's size, its features, and where it's located in the world.



A session on music was provided to help children understand the importance of music in our lives. During the session, the children were taught Saraswati Vandana. The children learned the meaning of the prayer and sang with great enthusiasm, creating a joyful and spiritual atmosphere. The session also helped the

children stay connected to their cultural roots.



The topic of **Tenses** was taught. The concept was explained with simple examples from daily life. They learned to identify and use the correct tense. They practiced making sentences in different tenses. By the end, students were confident and shared their own examples. They understood the topic well. Each child also

received a bar of chocolate and a packet of biscuits at the end of the session. This small treat added to their excitement and made the learning experience even more memorable.



A lesson on **patterns** was conducted. In this lesson, students explored different patterns found in nature and their surroundings. **They observed examples like classroom window designs**, **leaf venation, honeycombs, and dupatta patterns.** The students practiced drawing and completing patterns in their notebooks, which helped them understand the concept better. A student volunteer, Tanish, actively helped the children understand the concept better and guided them throughout the session, making the lesson more effective.



A session on self-confidence encouraged students to share experiences and speak publicly, helping them overcome hesitation and build confidence. To make the session engaging, a PowerPoint presentation was used, helping students understand the topic in a better way. This combination of speaking, sharing personal experiences, using visual aids and practical activities makes the learning process more effective.



As part of vocational training, children were taught how to make hot air balloons using waste materials. They used colourful dry clay to make small balls and then used the waste materials to create hot air balloons. This activity aligns with **Sustainable Development Goal 12**:



Responsible Consumption and Production by encouraging the use of waste materials in a productive way and promoting sustainability. This activity is also in line with the National Education Policy (NEP), which suggests that children should learn vocational skills. NEP emphasises teaching practical skills to students to help them become more employable in the future.

Another session took place on the topic of **'Prepositions.' Using pictures and visual aids, such as drawings on the board, the idea was explained in a simple and friendly manner. Prepositions were illustrated in playful ways, helping the students grasp the concepts more easily. Vocational training session on making Christmas cards took place, bringing the festive spirit into the classroom. Children learned important skills like creativity, paying attention to details and hands-on craftsmanship.**
