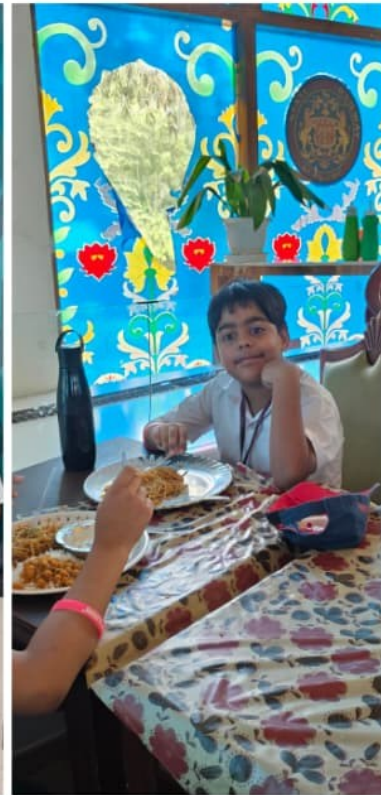
Classes III to V
