### **Highlights of the Week**

- Class IV: Little Poets – Dress Up & Recitation**

Our youngest participants embraced the spirit of poetry by dressing up as characters or symbols from selected poems and reciting them with confidence and flair, bringing rhythm and rhyme vividly to life.

- Class V: Twist the Tale – Creative Endings**

Budding storytellers reimagined the endings of well-known tales, crafting surprising and inventive conclusions that reflected originality and a strong grasp of narrative flow.

- Class VI: Caption This! – Picture Prompt Writing**

Students used visual prompts as a springboard for creativity, composing compelling captions and descriptive passages that demonstrated keen observation and imaginative thinking.

- Class VII: Stagecraft Stories – The Skit Showdown**

In this lively event, teams collaborated to write and perform short skits. It was a perfect blend of scriptwriting, dramatization, and performance, promoting teamwork, stage presence, and vocal clarity.

- Class VIII: Comic Con – Comic Strip Creations**

Students combined visual art with storytelling by designing their own comic strips. Their work showcased humor, creativity, and the ability to convey narratives in a concise and engaging format.

- Class IX: Turn Coat – Duel of Doubts**

Participants rose to the challenge of this impromptu debating format, switching viewpoints mid-argument. This activity honed their spontaneity, reasoning, and persuasive speaking skills.

- Class X: Manipulated Melodies – A Modern Retelling**

Learners gave classic tales a contemporary twist, presenting retellings set in the modern world while retaining the core messages. This exercise bridged timeless narratives with current realities.

- **Class XI: If I Were Them – Character’s Voice Reimagined**

Students stepped into the shoes of literary characters and presented reflective monologues, creatively expressing thoughts and emotions that might exist beyond the written page.

- **Class XII: TED Talk – Thoughts Worth Sharing**

Senior students curated and delivered impactful talks on topics close to their hearts, inspired by the TED format. Their confident presentations reflected clarity of thought, research, and compelling communication.
