



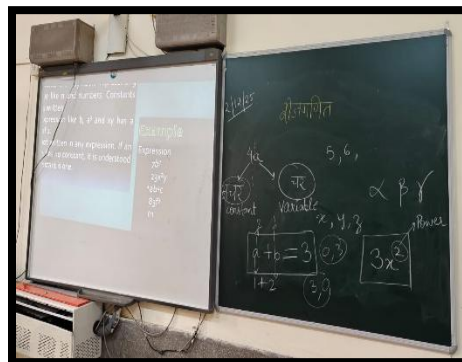

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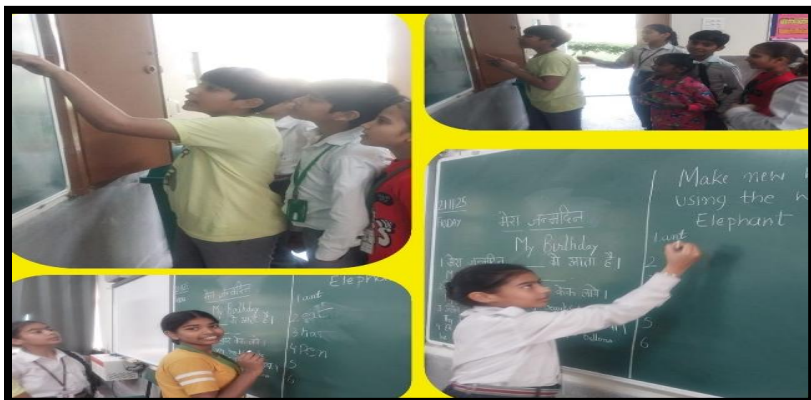
Vivekananda Paathshala (December 2025)

“When learning reaches every child, communities grow stronger.”

Jaspal Kaur Public School continues its commitment to community service through *Vivekananda Paathshala*, an initiative that supports marginalised children by providing access to quality education and learning resources. Aligned with the UN Sustainable Development Goals, **SDG 1 (No Poverty)**, **SDG 4 (Quality Education)**, and **SDG 10 (Reduced Inequalities)**, the initiative works to reduce educational gaps and create equal learning opportunities. The enthusiastic participation of students highlights their strong desire to learn and reflects JKPS’s dedication to inclusive and meaningful education.



Students learned basic **Algebra** by identifying constants, variables, and powers. The smart board helped explain examples clearly in both Hindi and English, supporting inclusive and quality learning. Students participated enthusiastically, shared answers confidently, and received gentle guidance when needed. This activity supported **SDG 4 – Quality Education** by encouraging understanding, participation, and equal learning opportunities for all students.



The students were guided to **frame simple sentences** on the topic “**My Birthday**” in both English and Hindi. They also practiced forming new words from a single word and revised the use of **Magical Golden Words** such as *Please*, *Sorry*, *Thank You*, and *Excuse Me*, helping them develop good communication habits and values. Students participated with enthusiasm and confidence, and their efforts were appreciated with sweets and stationery.



A special and engaging class was conducted on the **basics of electricity**. The concept of how electricity is generated was explained through a simple demonstration, which sparked curiosity and excitement among the children. The interactive approach helped students grasp the idea easily, and they actively enjoyed the learning experience. The session concluded on a cheerful note, with each child receiving a chocolate as a small token of encouragement and appreciation. This initiative supports the **SDG 7 – Affordable and Clean Energy**, by introducing young minds to fundamental concepts of energy and electricity at an early age.



The Paathshala session was conducted for students of Classes 9–12, introducing them to the core concept of **entrepreneurship**. Students learned how to think like entrepreneurs, understanding that anyone can start a venture with creativity and a positive mindset. Real-life examples such as Zepto and Dhirubhai Ambani were shared to illustrate the journey of successful entrepreneurs. The students participated enthusiastically throughout the session. It concluded with a brief recapitulation, followed by the distribution of oranges. This session aligns with the **UN Sustainable Development Goals**, particularly **SDG 8 – Decent Work and Economic Growth**, by nurturing entrepreneurial thinking and empowering young minds to contribute to future economic development.

A joyful session on **Rajasthani folk songs** was held with 16 students and the support of 3 volunteers. The children participated enthusiastically, singing along and enjoying the colourful folk music of Rajasthan. The volunteers ensured smooth coordination throughout the activity. The session ended with the distribution of **woollen caps**, bringing smiles and warmth to the children. This activity supports **SDG 4 – Quality Education** by encouraging cultural learning and **SDG 11 – Sustainable Cities and Communities** by promoting traditional folk heritage.
