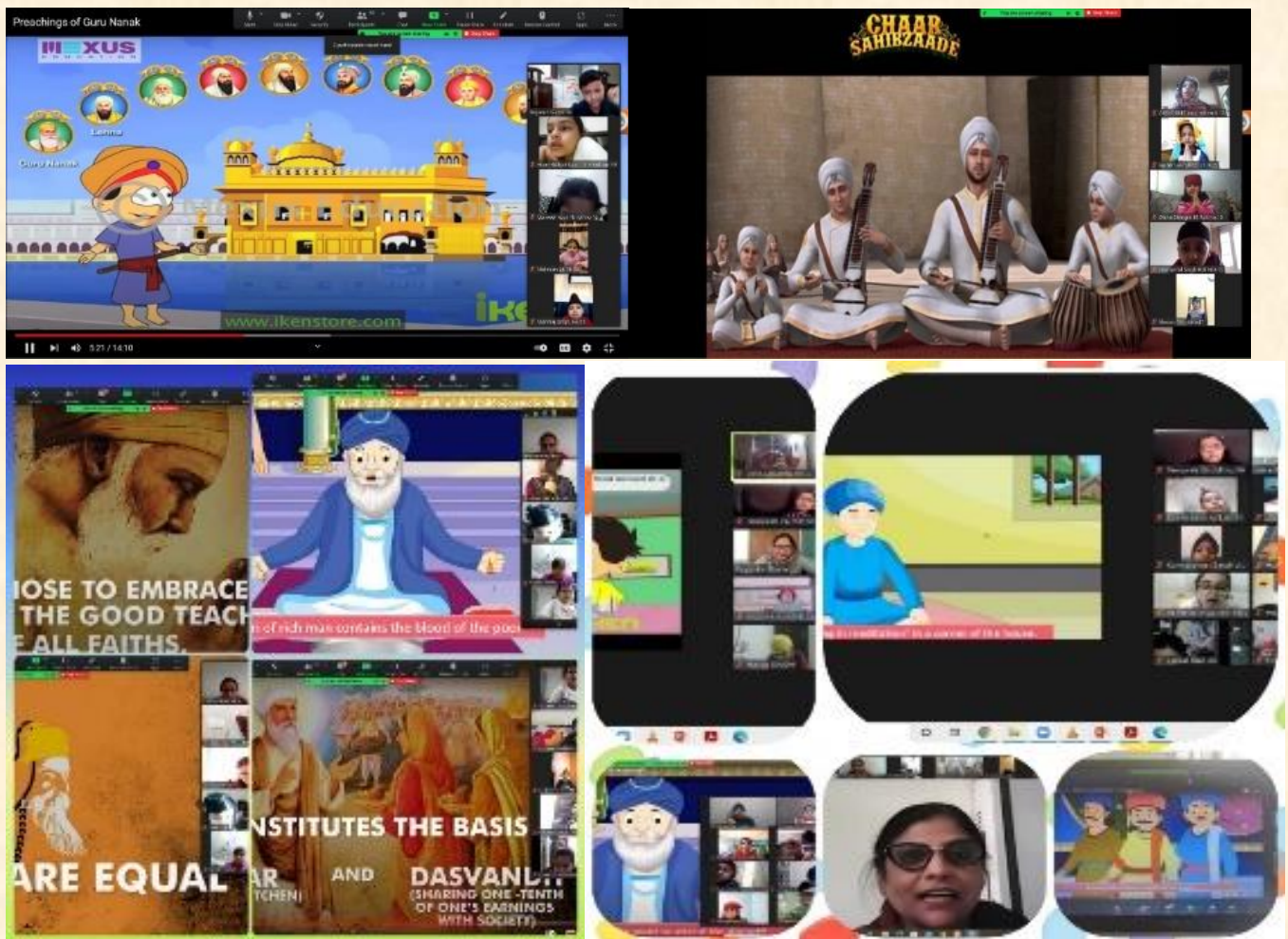


## NOVEMBER WEBSITE REPORT III TO CLASS V

### Assembly on Gurpurab

## Virtual Tour – Dental Hygiene

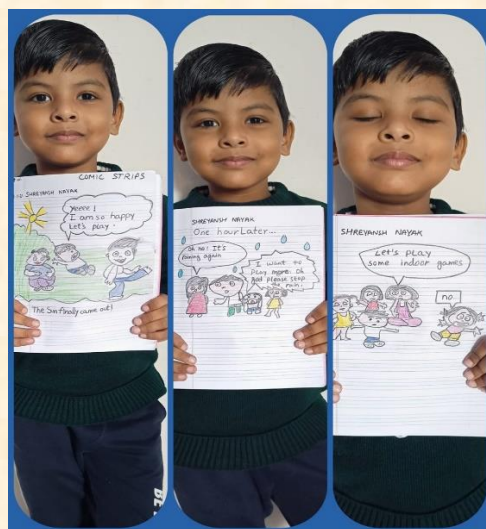

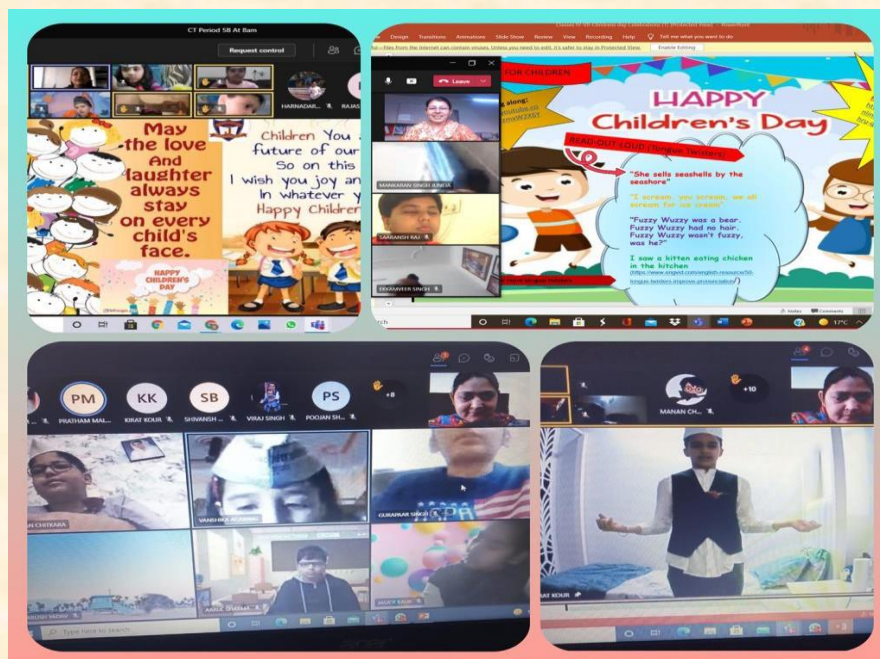
## Assembly on Children's Day
