The assembly aimed at propelling the young enthusiasts by laying stress on simple living to achieve goals.


Students were encouraged to adopt a simple and humble living with a broad outlook towards life. They were inspired through motivational videos to emulate this thinking in our life.




## LET'S ENJOY WITH FUN ACTIVITY

Collect the pictures of some great personalities who led simple lives. Paste them at the space given below, write their names and a few lines about each of them:





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
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
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
