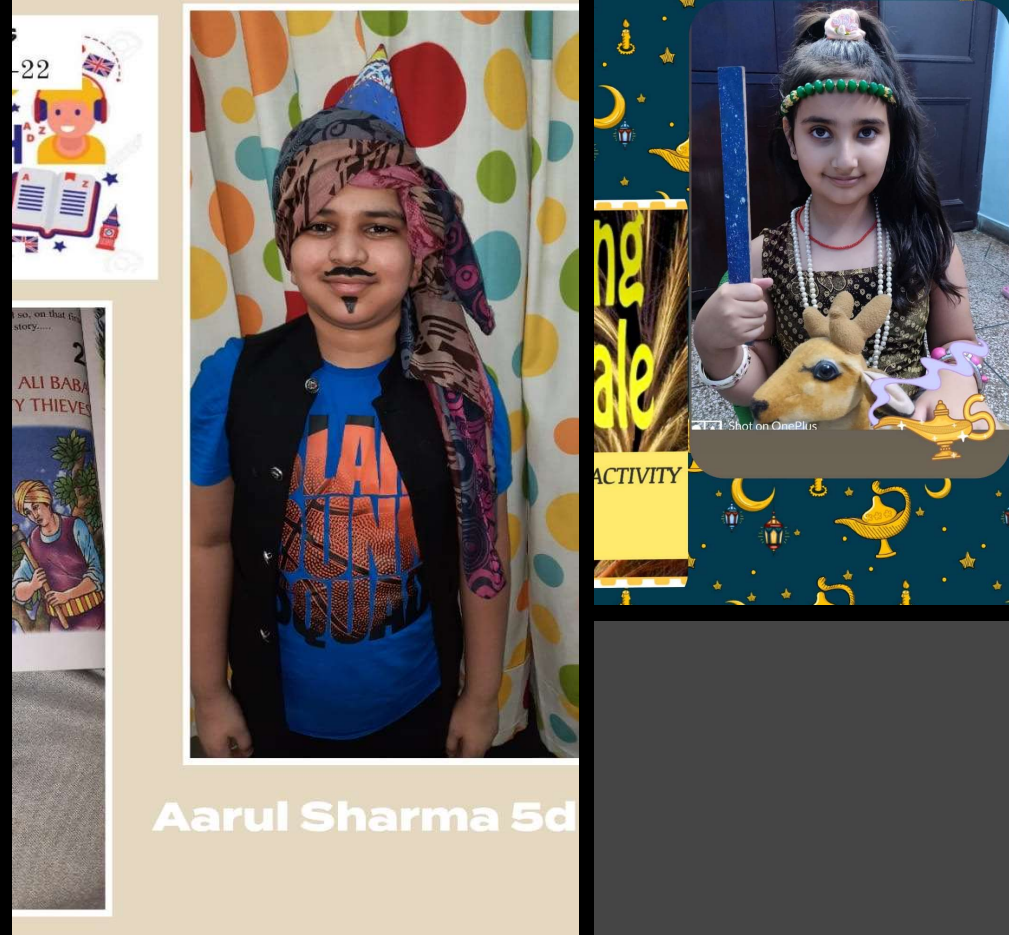
CLASS - V

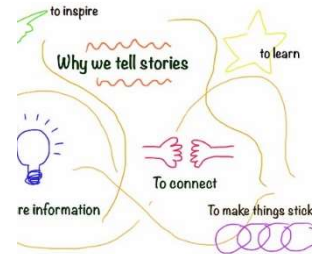


CLASS – VII

CLASS X

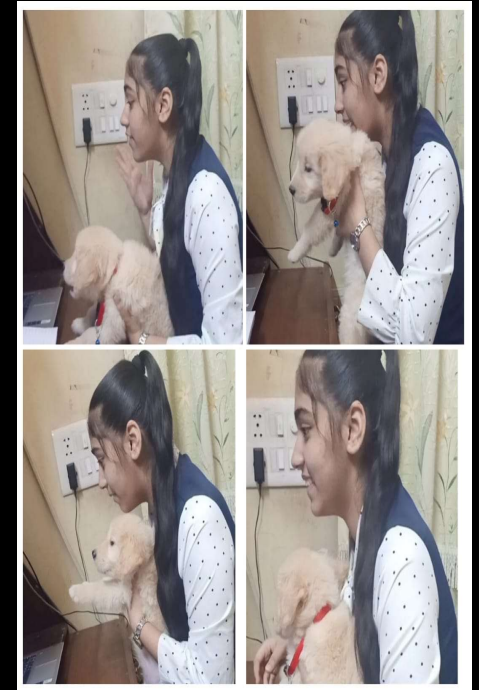


Activity : Characters Come Alive

Learners were supposed to bring to life any character from their book. They had to impersonate and enact that character

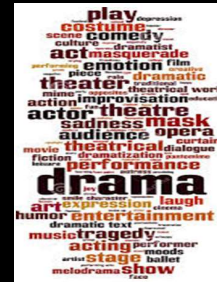
This activity challenged children to develop a more sensitive understanding of a variety of viewpoints whilst sharpening their language skills.
