On 7 September 2022, the Jaspalians went on a field visit to the Living Treasures dispensary situated in Singh Sabha Gurudwara, Mukherjee Nagar as part of the Community Outreach Programme along with Mr. C.P. Nayak.



The Living Treasures dispensary is a charitable organisation with centres all over India. They provide free healthcare and medicines to the people belonging to the lower economic sections of society. The commendable thing is that they charge a nominal amount of ₹ 10/- from the

patients so that everyone can afford it. There were a lot of volunteers as well. We were happy to know that all the volunteers worked there without any salary, of their own will. They guide the people who face any kind of difficulties.

We also met Mr. Narander Pal Singh, who is a volunteer and also contributes a part of his income to the organization. Dr. JS Kapoor provides free medical services to about 50-60 patients daily.



The Jaspalians also contributed to the charitable dispensary by distributing 800 tablets for illnesses like diabetes etc. It was a learning experience for all our students to see and understand the functioning of a charitable dispensary and to be of help to the community.
