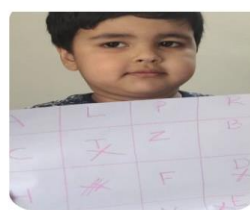
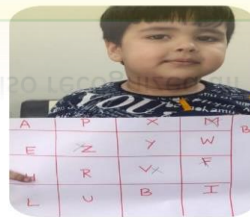
Name Train

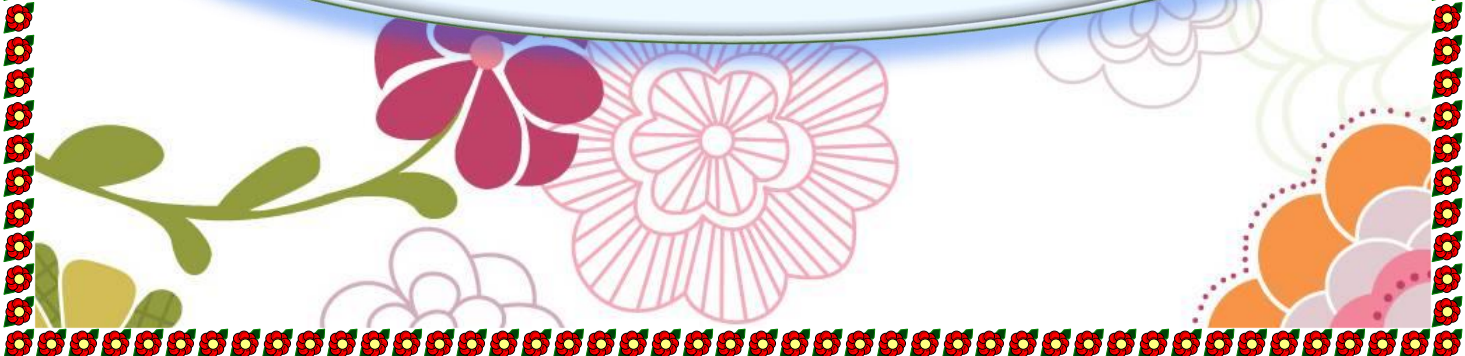
The Bingo Game

Emoji Cards

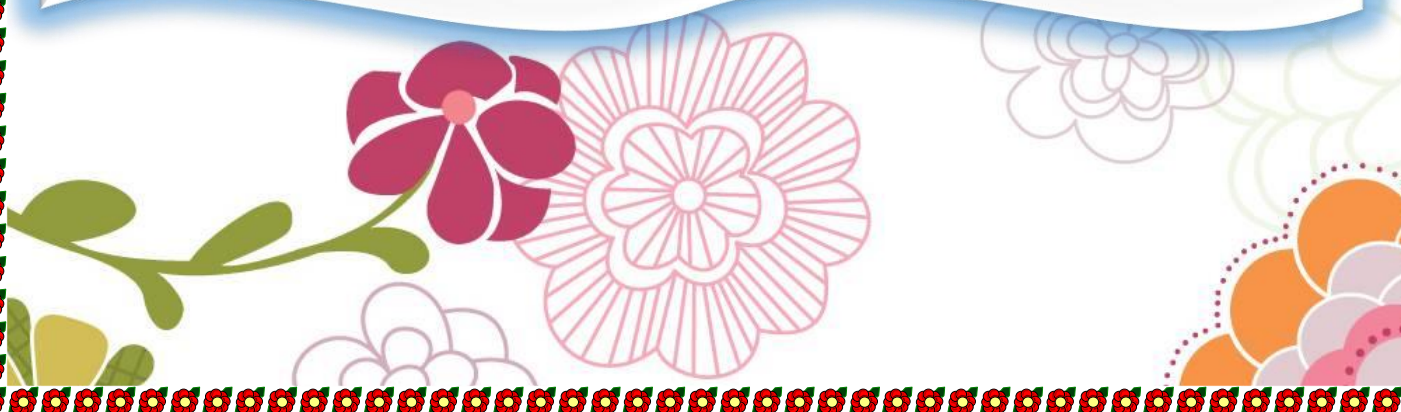

VIRTUAL TOUR

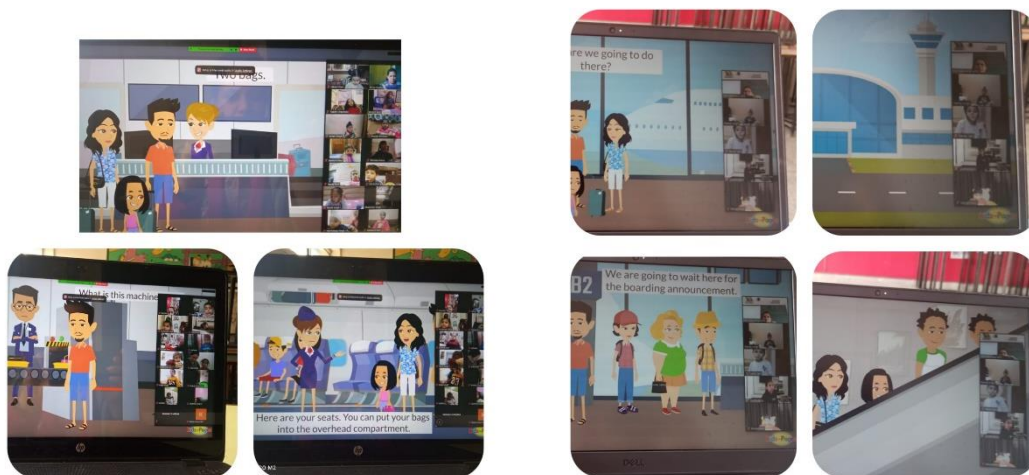
MUGHAL GARDEN

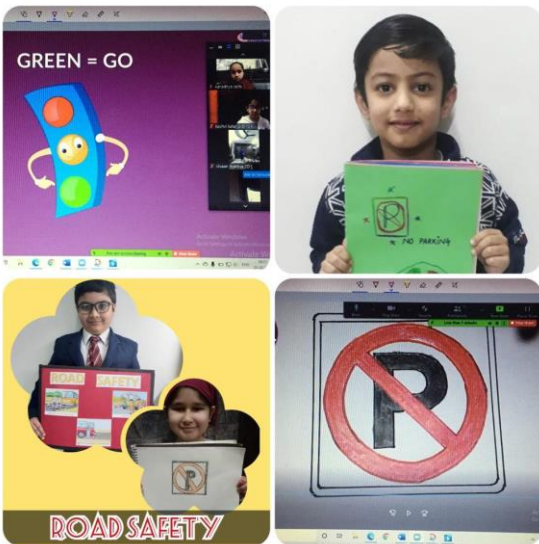
ASSEMBLIES

WORLD RADIO DAY

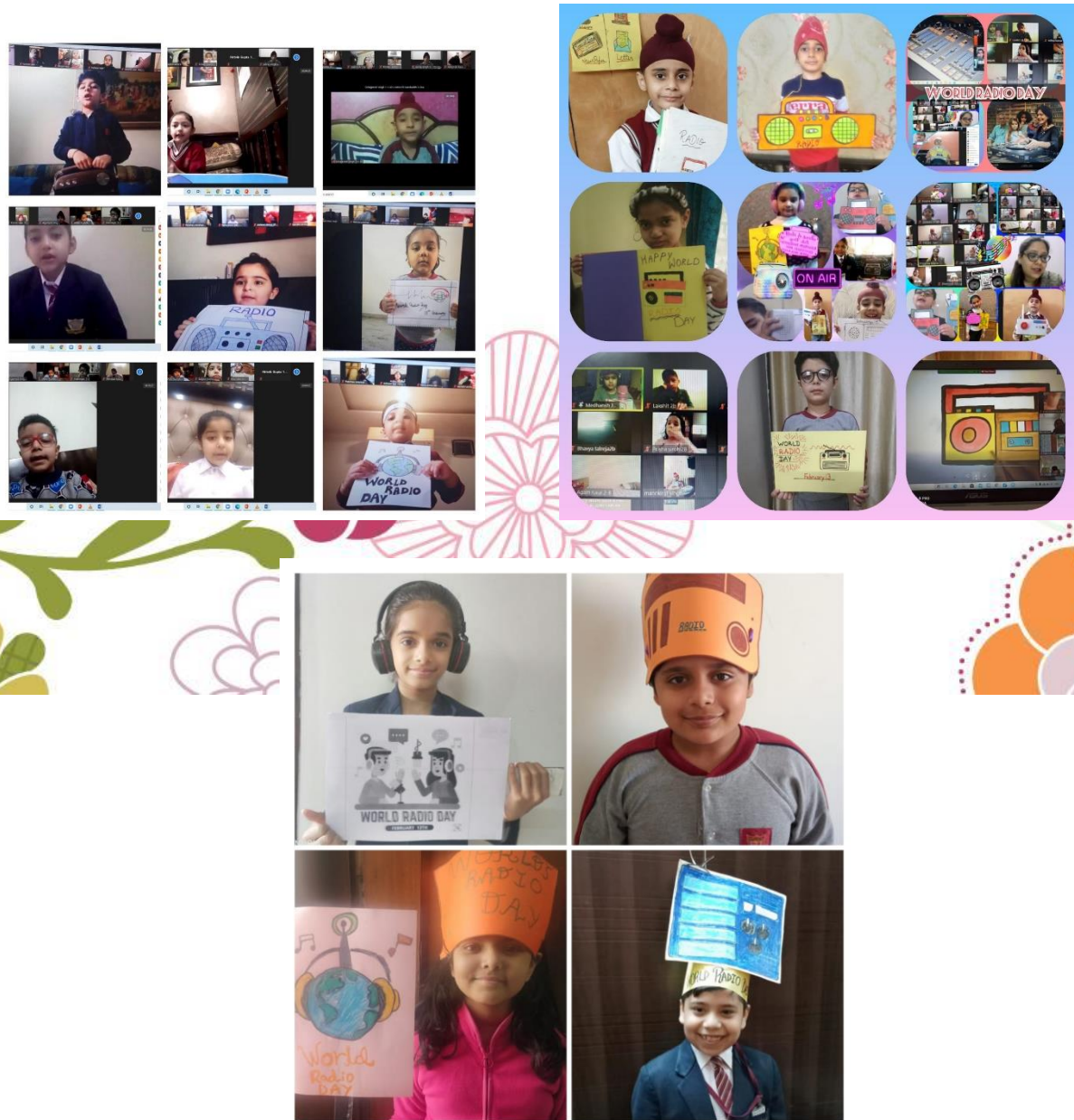
Date 12 Feb.2021

Students learnt and spoke about the theme "Radio and diversity"

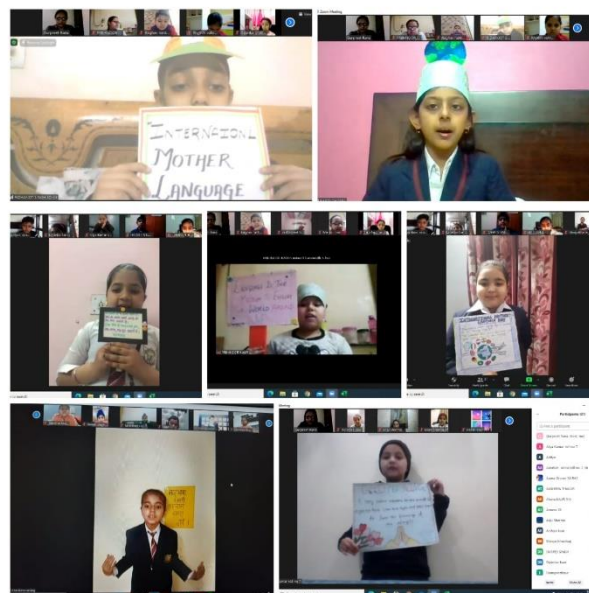
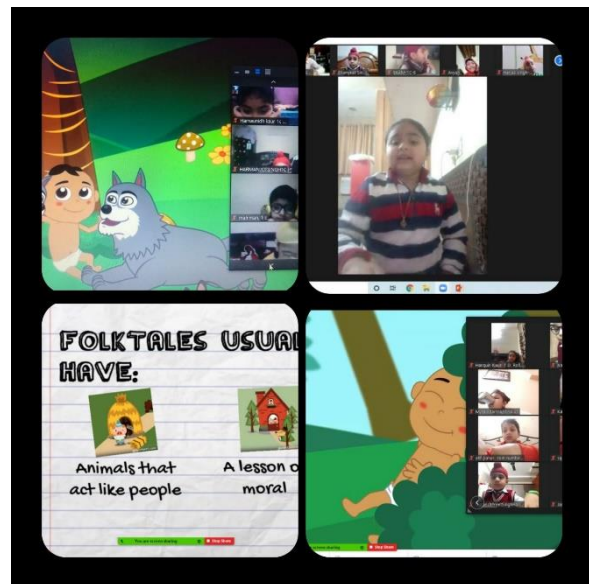
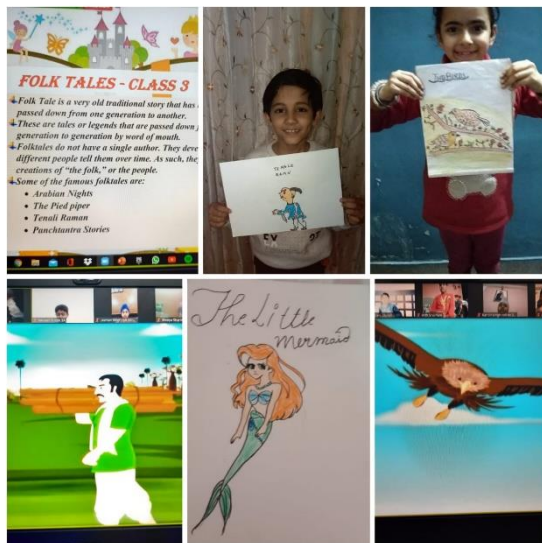
They understood why radio is important. Also, they shared how everyone still has a radio in their homes and discovered more about the radio.

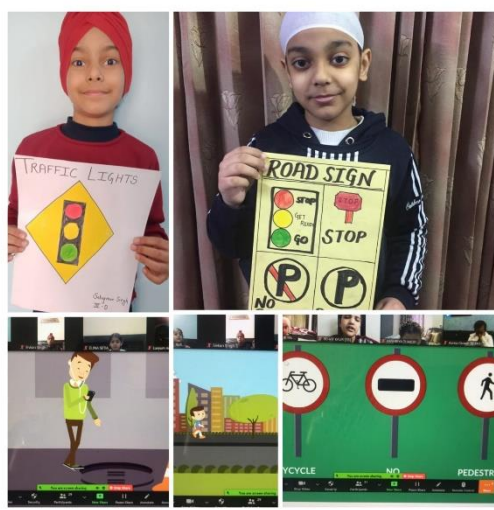
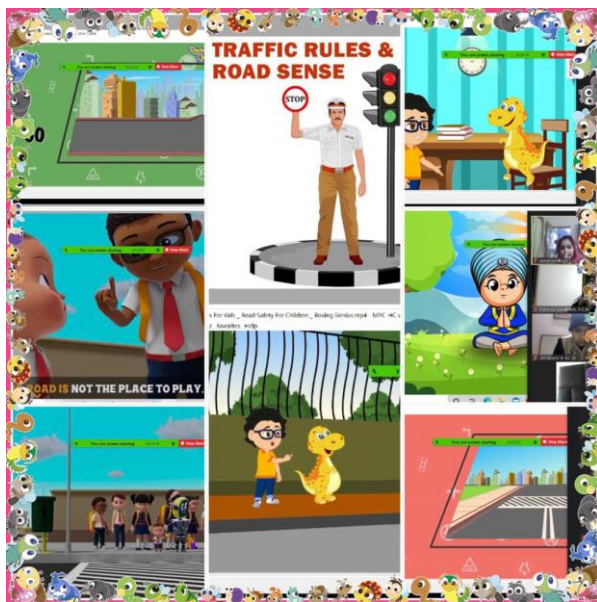
SAFETY

They also made road safety signs along with their meaning.

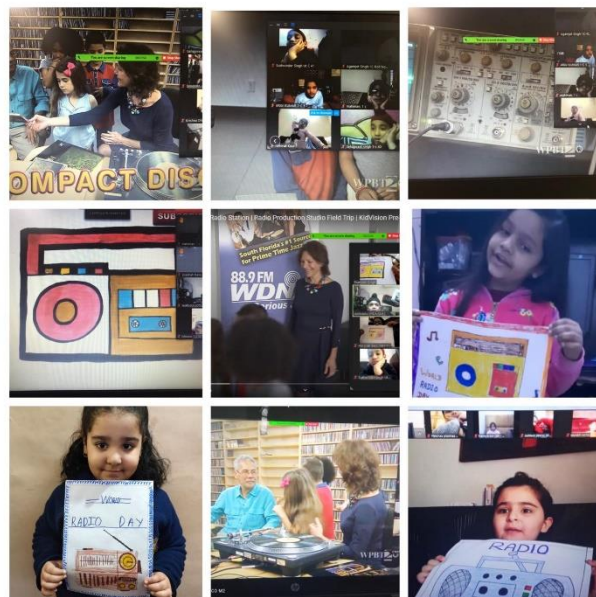
An educational video on Road Safety was also shown to them.



RADIO STATION

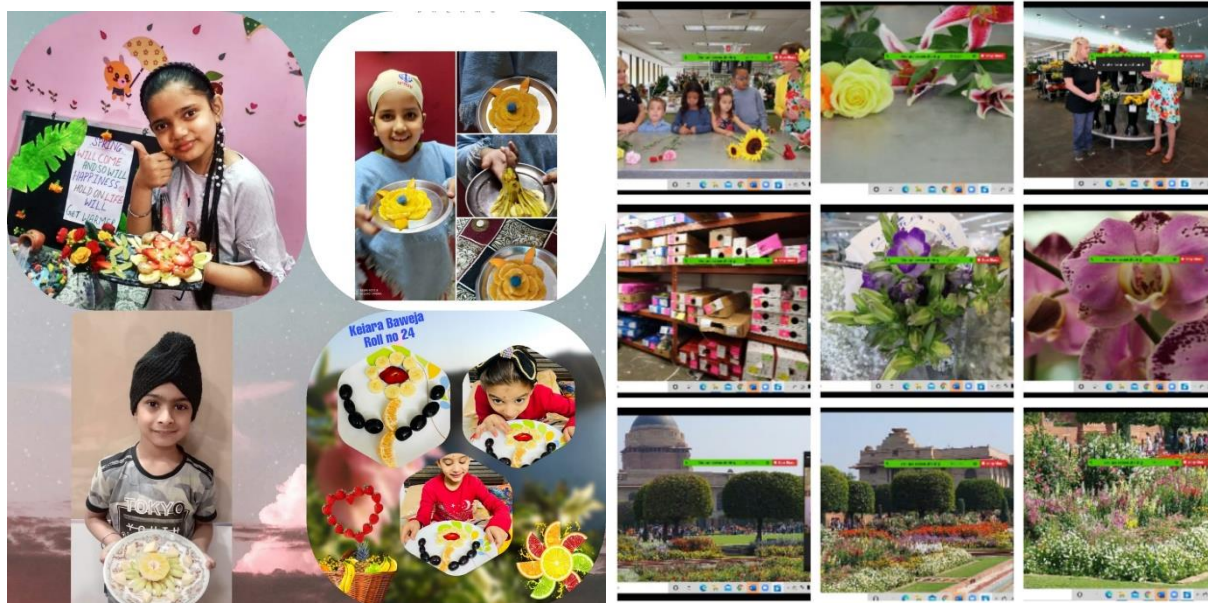

POWER OF SPEECH

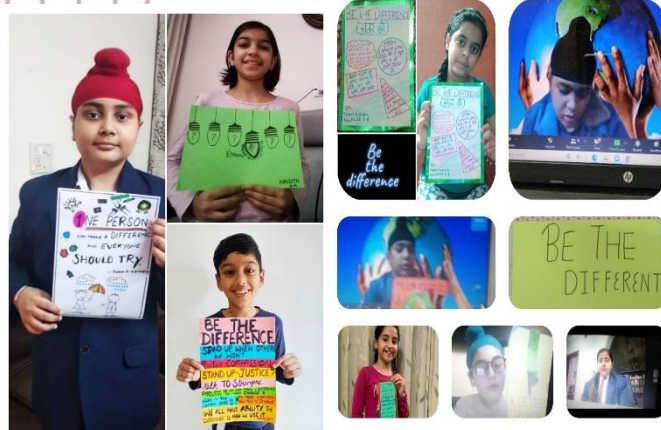
