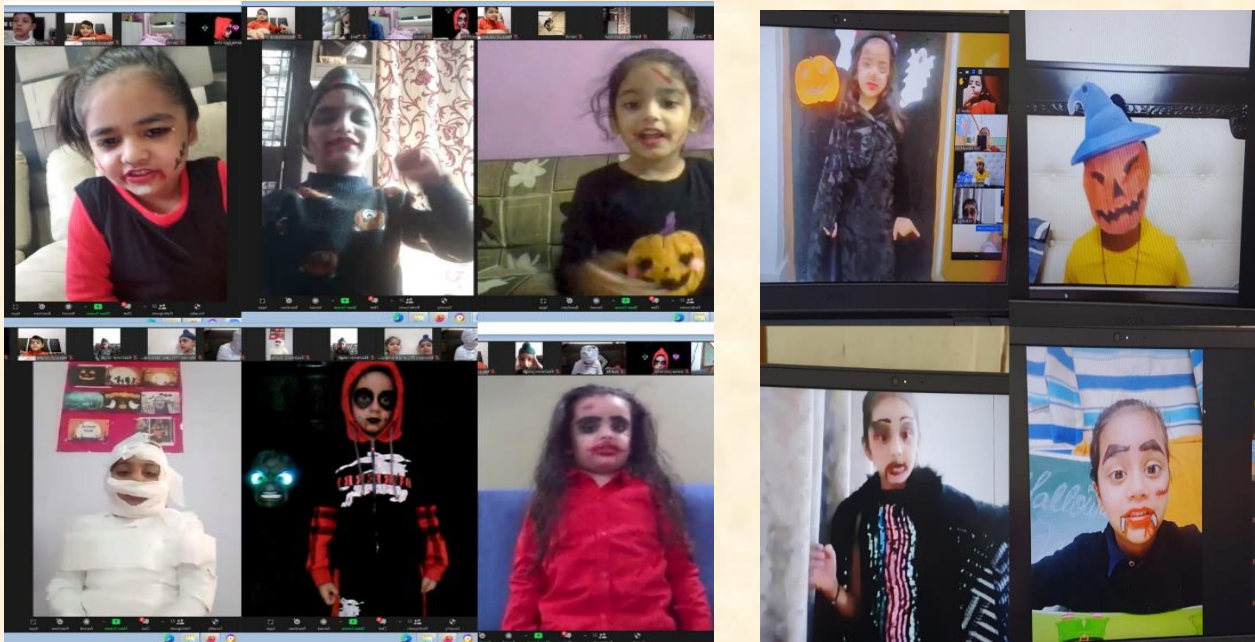

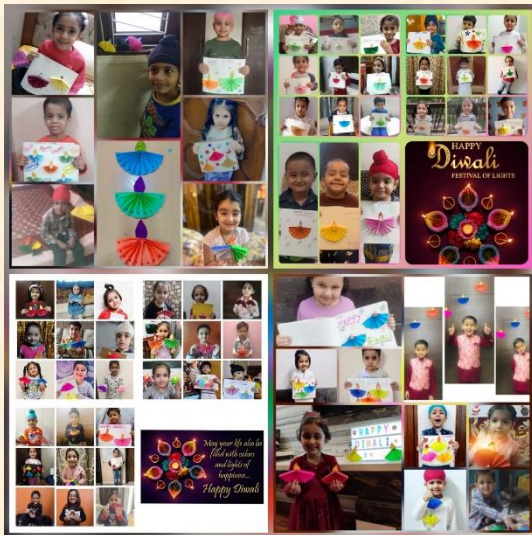
Assembly on Halloween

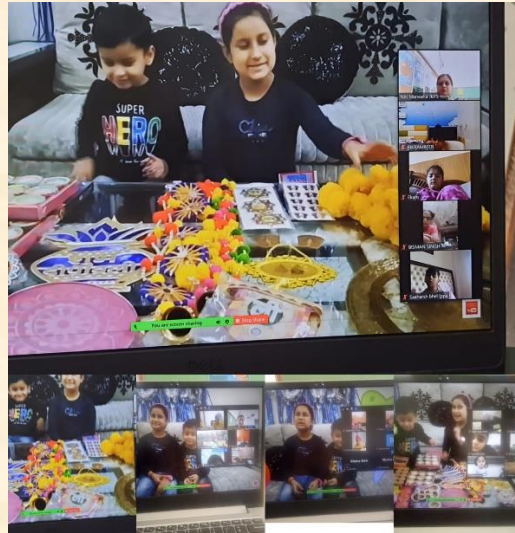
Assembly on Gurburab
